Imposition of Ashes

“Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.”

Lent begins from the 5th March and our communion services include the imposition of ashes where the sign of the cross is marked on your forehead in ash. It is a service of prayer & worship which focuses upon Christ's sacrifice, resurrection & ascension (return to Heaven) which we mark and celebrate as our means of salvation won for us by Jesus.

Holy Communion is available to any who is baptised. Should you not wish to receive Communion, our clergy would be most happy to give you a Blessing +

Stations of The Cross

At stations of the Cross services, we follow Jesus's last journey through the streets of Jerusalem culminating in his Crucifixion and burial in his tomb. This is a walk around the church stopping at each pictorial representation of the journey for prayer and meditation.

Good Friday April 18th (Joint service)

Stations of The Cross 11am at All Saints Church

Miserere mei, Deus, ("Have mercy on me, O God")

This is a joint service which includes music, prayer and meditation and culminates in a recording of "Miserere" by Gregorio Allegri.
